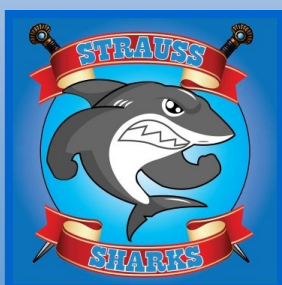

We also had to look into maths. Some of us showed our data through different types of graphs. Some others used timelines.

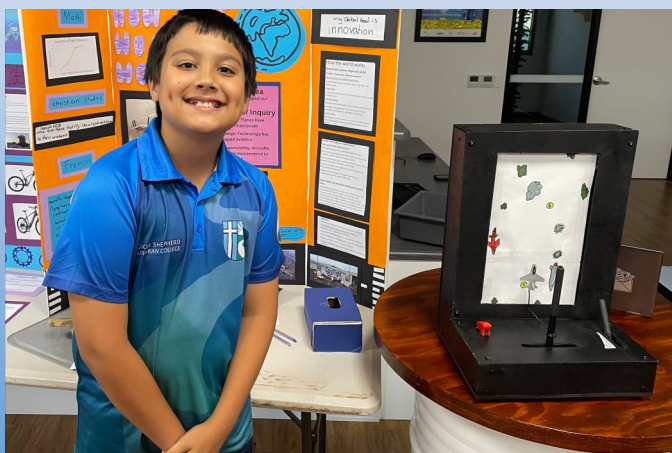
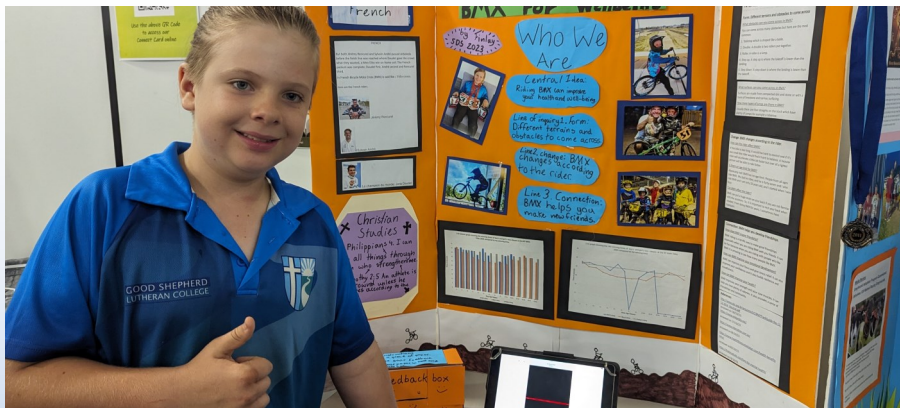

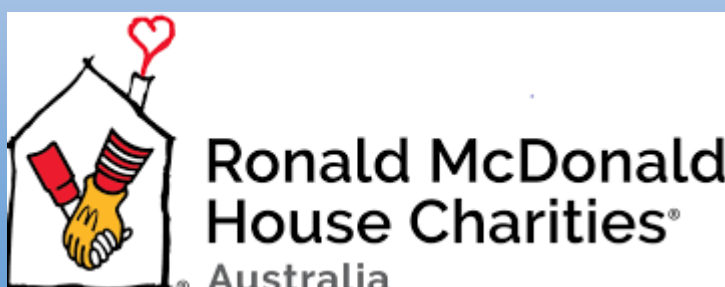


Gifts of Grace Week

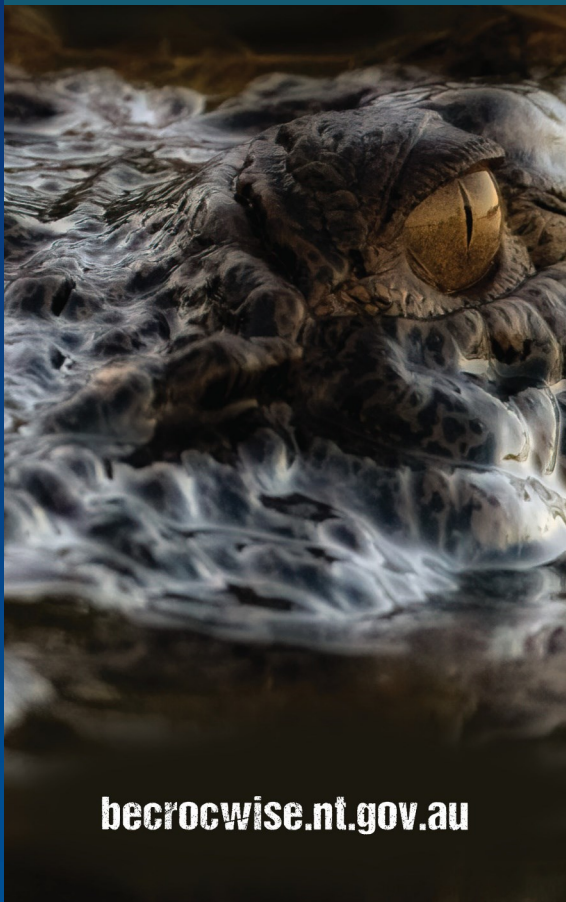

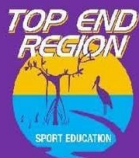
